Bible

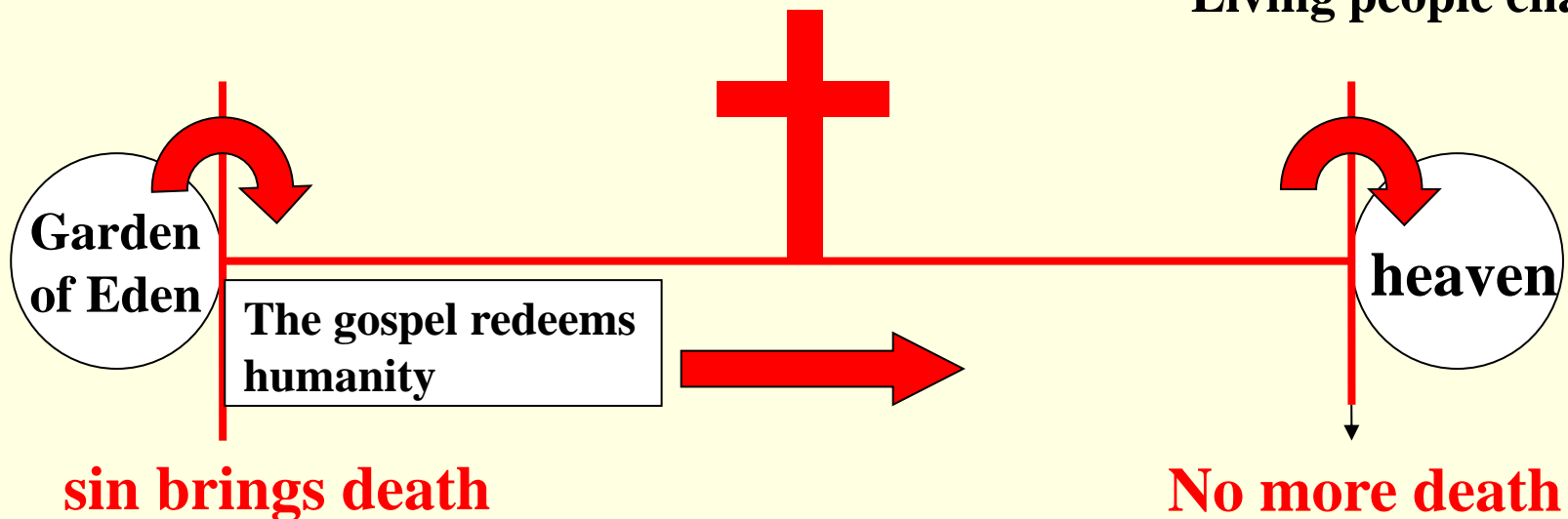
- God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, so that whoever believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.
